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# Mobile hospitals at odds over \$11.5M for indigent care

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Three months after the state Supreme Court dismissed a case regarding how to pay Mobile hospitals nearly \$11.5 million for indigent care, the three parties in the litigation remain unable to resolve the matter.

[According to the Press-Register](#), Jay Ross, the attorney for Mobile County, said he's been in talks with Mobile Infirmary, the University of South Alabama Medical Center and AltaPointe Health Systems to devise a way to distribute the funds "so all three could be satisfied."

Ross said USA and Mobile Infirmary have reached an agreement between themselves, but AltaPointe won't agree and he anticipates the matter will have to be addressed by the court again.
