## **Gov. Robert Bentley announces Alabama Department of Mental Health board appointments**

David Bennett and Probate Judge Jim Perdue were recently appointed, effectively immediately, to the Alabama Department of Mental Health's board of trustees by Gov. Robert Bentley.


Wade Perry Jr., a current member of the board initially appointed in 2008, was also reappointed. ADMH made the announcements in a news release Thursday.

Bennett represents the Seventh Congressional District and will serve until his term expires April 2015. He retired from ADMH as associate commissioner for the Division of Administration in 2008 after more than 17 years with the department.

Perdue is representing the Second Congressional District and serving a term that will expire April 2014. He has served as probate judge for Crenshaw County since 2002.

Perry represents the First Congressional District and will serve a term expiring April 2015. He began his career as a federal prosecutor in Montgomery, and has been with the Mobile law firm of Johnstone,
