

ADMH: Plans to Appeal Bentley Decision

(MOBILE, Ala.) - The Alabama Department of Mental Health plans to appeal a judge's ruling to continue treating Jeremy Bentley.

Bentley was found not guilty by reason of mental disease or mental defect and was being treated at a facility in Tuscaloosa.

Bentley strangled and beat to death a Mississippi man in 2000.

The mental health facility in Tuscaloosa says Bentley is "cured" and no longer needs their care.

This week a judge disagreed with that ruling ordering Bentley back.

The Mobile County District Attorney's office released this statement.

It reads in part "Bentley is one of the most dangerous people they've seen and needs to be kept away from the public."
